FOURTH GRADE SUPPLY LIST

2009 – 2010

All Students:

- Magellan student agenda (available at Meet the Teacher Day)
- TI-30 calculator (if you attended last year, Mrs. Muncie has yours)
- Pencil pouch: zipper kind, not box
- Scissors: adult size is best
- 2 narrow highlighters: different colors
- 4 glue sticks
- #2 pencils with erasers, pre-sharpened please ☺
(disposable mechanical are acceptable / no lead changing)
- 2 narrow black felt tip pens
- 1 box of colored pencils
- Index cards: 1 pack of 3x5 and 1 pack of 4x6
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 50 page protectors: top-loading, not quick-loading
- 1 composition notebook (marble cover)
- 5 packages of write-on dividers: 5 in each pack for a total of 25 tabs
- 2 very durable / heavy duty binders:
 - One blue – 2 inches wide
 - One green – 1 ½ inches wide

Boys only:

- 1 box of family size tissues
- 1 bottle of all-purpose cleaner (like 409)
- 1 box of sandwich-size Ziploc bags

** Please DO NOT OPEN any of the paper, dividers, etc. and load into binders. We will do this with kids!

Girls only:

- 1 bag of individually wrapped candies
